

Postgraduate Breakfast Event – Terms and Conditions

1. Instructions on how to enter and other details contained within promotional advertisements for this competition form part of the conditions of entry.
2. By entering the competition, entrants agree to abide by these Terms and Conditions.
3. The Terms and Conditions of this competition are governed by the laws of the State of Western Australia.
4. The competition is being run by Curtin University, GPO Box U1987, Perth, Western Australia, 6845 (“Curtin University”).
5. The Postgraduate Breakfast (“the competition”) commences at 8:30am Australian Western Standard Time (AWST) on 28 October 2021
6. The closing time for entering the competition is 9am AWST on 28 October 2021
7. Entry to the competition is limited to guest who register and attend in person the Postgraduate Breakfast event at Curtin 137 St Georges Tce.
8. To enter the competition, the entrant must:
 - (a) register online (curtin.edu/postgrad-breakfast) to attend the 2021 Postgraduate Breakfast event; and attend the event in person at 137 St Georges Tce and be present to receive the prize; and
9. Entry to the competition is free. Entrants will be responsible for all costs associated with entering the competition, which may include costs associated with accessing the internet.
10. Entrants may only enter the competition once.
11. Staff employed by Curtin University and their immediate family members are not eligible to enter the competition.
12. There will be three (3) prizes. First prize will be Apple store gift voucher to the value AUD\$250; second prize will be JB HiFi gift voucher to the value of AUD\$150 and third prize will be State Building gift voucher to the value of AUD\$100.
13. There will be three (3) draws at 8.30am Australian Western Standard Time on 28 October 2021 at Curtin 137 St Georges Tce. The draw will be by random barrel draw from all eligible entries received with the first three entries drawn being the first, second and third prize winners.
14. The prize winners will be announced by the event organiser at the event at the time of the draw.
15. If the prize winner does not respond to claim the prize at the time of the draw, a re-draw will be conducted immediately after, in the same location, and with the same method. Redraws will continue in the same manner until all prizes have been claimed by prize winners.
16. If the prize winner is under the age of 18 years, the prize will be awarded to the winner’s parent or legal guardian.
